



### How to fold your Valcamonica rock art paper game

-  1. Cut out the square
-  2. Fold to crease the 2 diagonals
-  3. Fold the four corners into the centre
-  4. Turn over and fold the corners again into the centre
-  5. Turn over and fold in half and reopen in both directions
-  6. Open up the shape to play
